Vacation Bible School. Please watch the church Facebook page for updates regarding Bible School. With social distancing orders in place, plans are uncertain.

Members of St. Paul Lutheran Church:

These are unprecedented times with difficult situations that require much personal diligence and thought. As we arrive at a time to return to worship at St. Paul, remember that your personal safety and space is of highest priority. As a Church Council, we feel that each member should know what has been thought about and recommended. Here are the conditions and changes that will be in effect when worship services begin again. We will begin on June 7, 2020, at 10:00am.

- 1) Masks are encouraged or recommended but not required.
- 2) There will be <u>no</u> Sunday School, children's sermon, passing the peace, or attendance pads.
- 3) The collection plates will be placed at the east and west entrances to the sanctuary, and maybe one up front. There will be <u>no</u> collection taken during the church service.
- 4) We are going to try to enforce the six foot social distancing rule. We are going to skip pews in order to obtain the necessary six feet.
- 5) Lighting of the candles will be done by the deacon or other Church Council member.
- 6) Bulletins will be available in the track rack at the east entrance and on a table at the west entrance. Congregation members can pick up their own bulletins.
- 7) We will be using the hymnals for the service liturgy and we will be singing hymns.
- 8) Handi-wipes and hand sanitizer will be available at each entrance to the sanctuary.
- 9) All door knobs, hand rails, elevator buttons, rest rooms, pews, and hymnal covers will be sanitized during the week before the next worship service.
- 10) Communion is still a work in progress, but one change will be after drinking the wine, the cup will be placed in a waste basket and not back in a communion rack.

Be informed that members may still contribute to the Lenten monies, Maundy Thursday, and Good Friday.

Confirmation will be held at a later date to be determined.

Bible School is still a work in progress; more information at a later date.

We are still working to livestream the worship services. The church website and Facebook will continue to have Pastor's weekly message. Once we return to worship services, the video of the week's service will still be available on the church website and Facebook.

We understand each person has his/her decision to make about attending the worship service. We want you to feel comfortable with whatever decision you make. If you are uncomfortable with the items above, we understand; and, please share your thoughts with us. If you do not feel well, please stay at home until you are feeling better.

of Dick and Betty Vance.







